2. Volunteer to work for the FBA during tournaments. FBA relies on parents to help raise funds for our travel team and other program needs.
3. I will make sure my player is at practice and games on time.

Parent's Code of Ethics:

1. I will remember that the game is for children not adults.
2. I will expect my child to treat other players, coaches, spectators and officials with respect.
3. I will assist in providing a positive team and association experience by volunteering my time as needed to help with the team and the association.
4. In the event of a conflict, I will wait an appropriate 24 hours before discussion.
